**NEW BULLOCKS JOIN TIMBERTOWN TEAM**

The famous bullock demonstration at Timbertown has two new 450 kg stars. Dusty and Ranger are two year old bullocks which were recently purchased from the Slater Bros at Kundabung. With the other bullocks in the team weighing on average 900kgs and being around 18 years old the new duo are certainly the younger and lighter members of the Timbertown team.

Both bullocks were born & reared on O'Leary's Glenmore Farm, a registered Devon stud owned by Richard & Patrick O'Leary. The O'Leary brothers and family have owned Glenmore since 1907 and have bred Devon's from the early part of last century. As part of a long held tradition of selling weaner steers to the Slater Bros the O'Leary's sold Dusty and Ranger to the Slater Bros when they were about 15 months old

Like the finest bred thoroughbreds bullock names are passed down from generations with some traditional Australian Bullock names having been used for the last 200 years. Dusty was born on the 19<sup>th</sup> of September 2003 and named after Slim Dusty as he was born on the day Slim died. Coincidentally his mate Ranger, born a month earlier on the 27 August 2003 had been named after Slim Dusty's mate Shorty Ranger.
